The incredibly talented Sakshi Gupta has often been likened to

an acrobat who jumps over all her contemporaries. She is a sculptor who works with a wide range of media as well as an eclectic choice of subjects—metal, feather, light, found objects. She even embarks upon sitespecific works, kinetic sculptures, fibreglass donkeys, metal eyelashes woven like a mattress and textiles.
